What are the full details of all measures that the Government will take, in addition to the measures that have already been taken and which have allegedly proven ineffective, to avoid any future ratings downgrades that will further impact negatively on investment facilitation and trade promotion in the Republic? ★9. Rev K R J Meshoe (ACDP) to ask the Deputy President:

- (1) What portion of its funding does the Moral Regeneration Movement (MRM) receive from the Government;

- (2) whether he has found evidence that indicates that financial support by the Government to the MRM is justified in view of the MRM's performance in achieving its aims and objectives? NO1433E
