**EMPLOYMENT OF MEMBERS OF THE SOUTH AFRICAN NATIONAL DEFENCE FORCE BY VIRTUE OF SECTION 201(2)(a) OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF SOUTH AFRICA, 1996 READ WITH SECTION 19 OF THE DEFENCE ACT, 2002 (ACT 42 OF 2002) FOR SERVICE IN COOPERATION WITH THE SOUTH AFRICAN POLICE SERVICE**

This serves to inform the National Assembly that I have employed 2 700 members of the South African National Defence Force (SANDF) for service in cooperation with the South African Police Service for the prevention and combating of crime and maintenance and preservation of law and order in the Republic of South Africa under Operation PROSPER.

It has been brought to the attention of the relevant authorities that Eskom power stations in almost all provinces are currently being targeted and made dysfunctional through acts of vandalism, destruction and sabotage by criminals.

Members of the SANDF employed will assist the South African Police Service in protecting Eskom power stations identified around the country.

The employment is authorised in accordance with the provisions of section 201(2)(a) of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, 1996 read with section 19 of the Defence Act, 2002.

The employment is from 16 December 2022 until 16 March 2023.

The expenditure expected to be incurred for this employment is R 206, 031,240.00 (Two Hundred and Six Million, Thirty-One Thousand, Two Hundred and Forty Rands).

I will communicate this report to members of the National Council of Provinces and to the Co-Chairpersons of the Joint Standing Committee on Defence and wish to request that you bring the contents hereof to the attention of members the National Assembly.
