Responding to question 21 asked by Hon. M Makesini:

- (i) *“We are focussing on upgrading the Amatola Bulk Water Augmentation Programme that is currently underway. This project will ultimately benefit rural communities through improved water security and socioeconomic development.”*
- (ii) *“I have been in the Free State myself, in places like Jakkalsfontein and Mangaung. We are going to try and focus a lot on the Free State because of the challenges you are raising. We are aware of them.”*
- (iii) *“The process that implementing within the security cluster to deal with the water mafia will also be used in the Free State so that we allow those municipalities to provide basic services like water without the mafia roaming around.”*

Responding to supplementary questions asked by Hon. BH Boshoff and Hon. M Peter to question 21:

- (iv) *“Okay, Dullstroom (eMakhazeni). Thank you very much. This is helpful. The reason I am asking is because I am going to be in Mpumalanga in the next few weeks on an outreach programme, and we will have to check that. I agree with you, I mean, human beings cannot drink water where animals drink. It’s not right”. So, we will have to address that and thank you for bringing it to my attention.”*
- (v) *“Regarding water crisis in KwaMaqoma and Makhanda: “Thank you very much, hon Peter. I’ll have to check progress with the Minister of Water on that matter.”*
