MOTIONS:

1. Draft resolution (Chief Whip of the Majority Party): That the House –
 - (1) notes with great sadness the tragic and untimely passing of the Deputy Minister of Mineral Resources and Energy, Ms Bavelile Gloria Hlongwa, in a car accident on the N1 travelling from Polokwane on Friday, 13 September 2019;
 - (2) further notes that it was reported that Ms Hlongwa's car had stopped to assist at another accident scene, when a truck crashed into the deputy minister's vehicle killing four other people;
 - (3) understands that at the time of the incident, Ms Hlongwa was returning from the 75th Anniversary celebrations and political school of the African National Congress Youth League (ANCYL) that was held at the University of Limpopo on that Friday;
 - (4) acknowledges that "Comrade BV", as she was popularly known, was appointed Deputy Minister of Mineral Resources and Energy by President Cyril Ramaphosa in May 2019;
 - (5) further acknowledges that prior to her appointment, she served as executive deputy chairperson of the National Youth Development Agency and was also a member of the ANC Youth League National Executive Committee;
 - (6) recalls that she studied at the University of KwaZulu-Natal Howard College, where she obtained a Bachelor of Science Degree in Chemical Engineering and was pursuing a Master's degree in Public Administration at the time of her death;
 - (7) believes that the death of Ms Hlongwa is a devastating and untimely loss of a talented young leader who, together with the Minister of

Minerals and Energy, played an important and dynamic role in an important sector of the economy;

- (8) further believes that the untimely death of Ms Hlongwa has left an immense void within the structures of the ANC, and that her death has robbed the country of one of its most committed public representatives; and
 - (9) extends its heartfelt condolences to the family, friends and colleagues of Deputy Minister Bavelile Hlongwa, as well as to the families of the four people who also tragically died in the accident.

2. Draft resolution (Chief Whip of the Majority Party): That the House, notwithstanding Rule 108(2) which provides that the time allocated to a member of each party for making a declaration of vote must be determined by the Rules Committee taking into account the proportional strength of the parties, limits the time allocated to a member from each party for making a declaration of vote on any Budgetary Review and Recommendation Report to not more than two minutes for the remainder of this annual session.

3. Draft Resolution (Chief Whip of the Majority Party): That the House –
- (1) notes that in the Fifth Parliament the National Assembly and the National Council of Provinces established the South African chapter of the Global TB Caucus on 4 September 2018;
 - (2) further notes that the South African chapter of the Global TB Caucus is intended, amongst others to -
 - (a) raise awareness and profile the TB epidemic and support efforts to accelerate the elimination of the disease by 2030 in line with targets set by the United Nations (UN) Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs); and
 - (b) provide a platform to Members of Parliament (MPs) and Members of Provincial Legislatures (MPLs) to champion the response to TB in the country and in their constituencies, and drive political action to end the disease;
 - (3) acknowledges that membership of the South African TB Caucus is on a non-partisan basis, open to any parliamentarian and/or legislator in South Africa and is undertaken on a completely voluntary basis; and
 - (4) resolves to establish, with the concurrence of the National Council of Provinces, a Joint Committee in terms of Joint Rule 142, to be the coordinating body for the duration of the Sixth Parliament, of the South African chapter of the Global TB Caucus, the Joint Committee to –
 - (a) consist of 11 members of the National Assembly and 9 Members of the National Council of Provinces;

- (b) be co-chaired by the Chairperson of the Portfolio Committee on Health in the National Assembly, and the Chairperson of the Select Committee on Health and Social Services in the National Council of Provinces, included in the above composition; and
- (c) exercise those powers in Joint Rule 32 that may assist it in carrying out its task.
