**ESTABLISHMENT OF AD HOC COMMITTEE ON VOTE NO 7 - NATIONAL
TREASURY - STATE SECURITY**

(Draft Resolution)

UMBHEXESHI OYINTLOKO WEQELA ELILAWULAYO: Somlomo weNdlu yoWiso-mthetho yeSizwe, ndiphakamisa ukuba ... *(Translation of isiXhosa sentence follows.)*

[The CHIEF WHIP OF THE MAJORITY PARTY: Hon Speaker of the National Assembly, I move ...]

That the House, noting the pending appointment of the Joint Standing Committee on Intelligence upon the finalisation of all legal prescripts, establishes an ad hoc committee ...

... iKomiti le yeThutyana yobuNtlola ejongene neemali nokuxoxwa kwalo mcimbi uqubisana nokwakhiwa kwale komiti. Kufuneka kubekho ikomiti eyodwa esekelwe ukwenza loo nto. Kungoko ke Somlomo namalungu ale Ndlu ndiphakamisa ukuba le komiti ibe namalungu a-11 aza kuthi abengoompondo zihlanjiwe abathe bagocwa-gocwa bafunyanwa bekulungele ukugcina imicimbi enobuzaza yeli lizwe. Eli 11 liza kwakhiwa ngolu hlobo lulandelayo: Aba bathandathu baza kube besuka kwi-ANC; ababini basuke kwi-DA aze omnye asuke kwi-EFF. Amanye amaqela la mancinci aza kumelwa ngabantu ababini. *(Translation of isiXhosa paragraph follows.)*

[... on Intelligence which deals with money and discussions on establishing that committee. There should be a certain committee that deals with that. That is why, hon Speaker and hon members of this House, I move that the committee should be composed of 11 members who are experts who will be investigated and found fit to keep sensitive issues of this country. The 11 members will be appointed as follows: The six members will be from the ANC; Two members from the DA and one member from the EFF. Small political parties will be represented by two members.]

- (a) conduct its proceedings in closed sessions in terms of Rule 184(1)(b)(iii) and members to conduct their functions in a manner consistent with the protection of national security;
- (b) exercise those powers in Rule 167 it may deem necessary for the performance of its task; and
- (c) cease to exist upon the completion of the Debate on Vote 7 - National Treasury - State Security.

[(d) As they will be ad-hoc-elected members, they should not
wish to continue with the work when their term is over.
They are precisely ad hoc, and the committee will be
disbanded when the work is finished.

I so move. Thank you. [Applause.]]

Mr N SINGH: Hon Speaker, no objection to the motion but just the
translation. The hon Chief Whip should have said other parties
instead of small parties because it is definitely other parties.
Thank you. [Laughter.]

The SPEAKER: That is noted, sir. Other parties.

Motion agreed to.
