MOTIONS:

1. Draft resolution (Chief Whip): That the House suspends Rule 290(2)(a), which provides *inter alia* that the debate on the Second Reading of a Bill may not commence before at least three working days have elapsed since the committee's report was tabled, for the purpose of conducting the Second Reading today on the **Appropriation Bill** [B 5 – 2024] (National Assembly – sec 77).
2. Draft resolution (Chief Whip): That the House –
 - (1) notes that Rule 17.1.2 of the PARMED Medical Aid Scheme Rules, as amended in July 2021, states that four (4) Members of Parliament from the National Assembly and the National Council of Provinces (NCOP) shall be appointed as representatives on the PARMED Board of Trustees;
 - (2) further notes the resolution of the National Council of Provinces on 9 July 2024 appointing Mr K M Mmoiemang as the NCOP representative on the Board of Trustees; and
 - (3) appoints Dr A Lotriet (Deputy Speaker of the National Assembly), Mr E J Marais (DA), and Dr S M Dhlomo (ANC), as National Assembly representatives on the Board of Trustees.
3. Draft resolution (Chief Whip): That the House –
 - (1) notes that the Rules of the Political Office-Bearers Pension Fund require that, after a general election, members of the National Assembly must elect four members as trustees and four as alternates to serve on the Board of Trustees of the Fund;

- (2) further notes that the Rules provide that two trustees and two alternates are members of the majority party and the remaining two trustees, and two alternates are from amongst members of the minority parties;
 - (3) elects as trustees Ms A Ramolobeng (ANC), Dr C H H Hunsinger (DA), Mr E M Ntshingila (MK), and Dr C P Mulder (Other Parties); and
 - (4) elects as alternate trustees Ms D R Direko (ANC), Mr J N de Villiers (DA), Mr N Ndhlela (MK) and Ms O M C Maotwe (Other Parties).
4. Draft resolution (Chief Whip): That the House resumes proceedings on the following Bills, which in terms of Rule 333(2) lapsed on the last sitting day of the Sixth Parliament, from the stage that they had reached on that day:
