EMPLOYMENT OF MEMBERS OF THE SOUTH AFRICAN NATIONAL DEFENCE FORCE FOR SERVICE IN COOPERATION WITH THE SOUTH AFRICAN POLICE SERVICE 28 JUNE 2026 TO 31 JULY 2026: OP PROSPER IN THE EVENT OF REQUIRED EMERGENCY HEIGHTENED SECURITY MEASURES IN ALL PROVINCES OF THE REPUBLIC OF SOUTH AFRICA

This serves to inform the National Assembly that I have employed Three Thousand Four hundred and Five (3 405) members of the South African National Defence Force (SANDF) for service in cooperation with the South African Police Service (SAPS) to prevent and combat crime and maintain and preserve law and order in the country.

Members of the SANDF employed will assist the SAPS in maintaining law and order in the country during the countrywide planned marches against illegal immigrants. Members of the SANDF employment will be on standby for any eventualities.

The employment is for the period 28 June 2026 to 31 July 2026.

This employment is authorised in accordance with the provisions of section 201(2) (a) of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, 1996.

The expenditure expected to be incurred for this employment amounts to **R 54 603 584.00**.

I will communicate this report to the Chairperson of the National Council of Provinces. I kindly request that you bring the contents of this letter to the attention of Members of the National Assembly.
